### New CT Car Seat Law

Effective October 1, 2017

Infants <u>Rear-Facing</u> until a minimum of 30 pounds AND 2 years old



Toddlers in <u>5-Point Harness</u> until 40 pounds AND 5 years old



In <u>Booster Seat</u> until a minimum of 60 pounds AND 8 years old
